

Règlement

Boulbi CUP U11 - Ice Hockey Tournament - Les Tigres de Boulogne	
Teams	8 teams. 20 games, each team play 5 games.
Team Composition	minimum : 10 players + 1 goalie - Maximum : 20 players + 2 goalies
Preliminary Games	
Number of games	3 (2 groups of 4 teams) every team play a game against each of others from the same group
Punctuality	Each team must be ready to play at least 5 minutes before their game begins. Otherwise a forfeit will be declared
Warm-up	2 minutes - pucks not allowed
Length of the Game	2 x 15 minutes with stoppage time. 2 minutes break at halftime - no changeover no more stoppage time if a team is winning by 4 goals or more. Time-out are not allowed Game points are awarded after each half time
Changes	players are substituted on the fly goalie can be replaced by a player at any time
Win	3 points
Tie	2 points
Loss	1 point
forfeit	0 point (game lost 5-0)
Ranking	Points are awarded for each match with teams ranked in the group based on the total number of points.
In the event of a tie on points, the following criteria will be applied in the order:	a) Points comparison among the teams
	b) Goals difference comparison among the teams
	c) General goals difference
	d) Number of goals
	e) Total number of players in the team including goalies
	f) team with the youngest player (birth date)
Play Off and Ranking games	
Number of games	2
Warm-up	2 minutes - pucks not allowed
Ranking	Based on the preliminary ranking : 3rd and 4th team play crosswise against the teams from another group. The winners play for 5th, the losers play for 7th place. 1st and 2nd team play crosswise against the teams from another group. The winners reach the final, losers play 3rd place.
Length of the Game	30 minutes (2 x 15 minutes) with stoppage time finals (1st and 3rd place) : 45 minutes (3 x 15 minutes) 2 minutes break at halves - no changeover no more stoppage time if a team is winning by 4 goals or more. Time-out are not allowed
Changes	players are substituted on the fly goalie can be replaced by a player at any time
When a game ends in a tie	Penalty shots will take place . Each team choose 3 players and who shoots the penalty will rotate from one team to another team. When there is still a tie, each team choose 1 player until a winner is determined. A player can not shoot 2 penalties as long as not all the field players on his team have already shooted
Game rules	
Overall Guidelines	The games will follow the valid rules of the IIHF and guidelines of FFHG for U11.
Checking	Body checking are not allowed
Fouls	minor penalty : 1 minutes in the box major penalty : 5 minutes in the box and disciplinary punishment : sit out for the rest of the game and next game
Disciplinary punishment	1 major penalty : sit out for one game 2 games exclusion or 2 major penalties : the player is not allowed to play in the entire tournament
Referee	Protests are not accepted and will be penalised
Regulations for the tournament	
Coaching Staff	no more than 4 designated people (coaches and staff) are located.
Discipline	Playing with hockey sticks, pucks, balls are is allowed in the ice rink arena. No running, no roller skating, no skateboarding... around the arena.
Disputes	Tournament organizer is responsible for the running of the tournament in accordance with the regulations and will take the necessary action for the efficiency of the tournament. No compensation shall be paid nor may any be claimed in this regard.
Closing Ceremony	The teams have to attend the closing ceremony and are asked to wear their jersey
Regulations	Participating in tournament implies the full and clear adherence to these rules.
